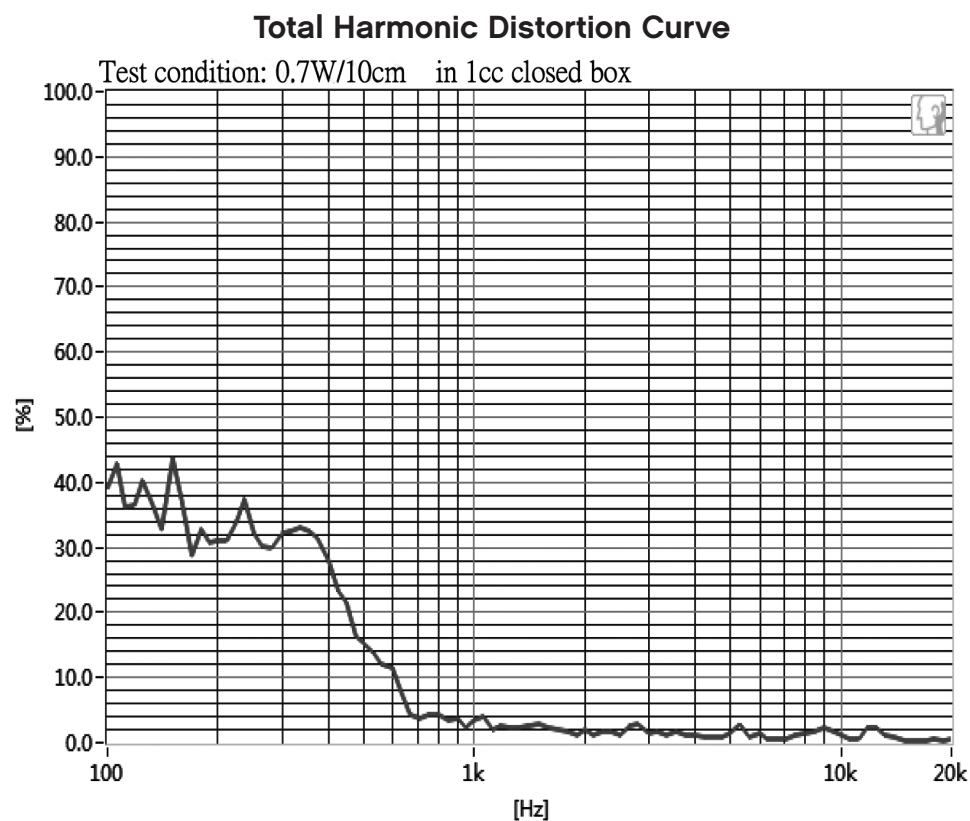
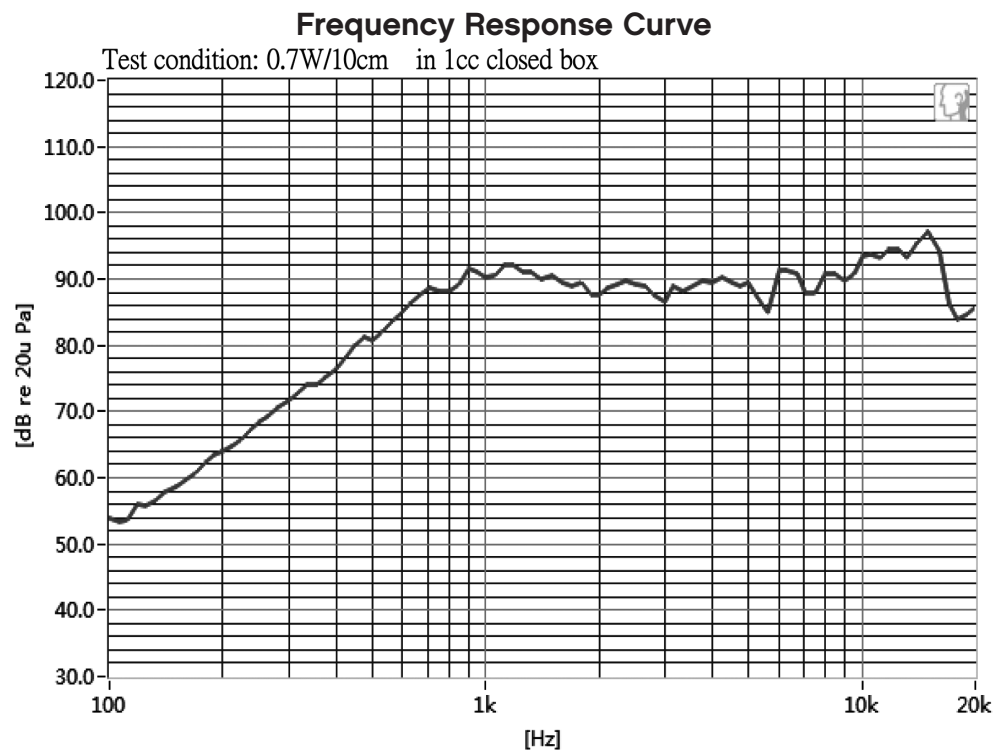

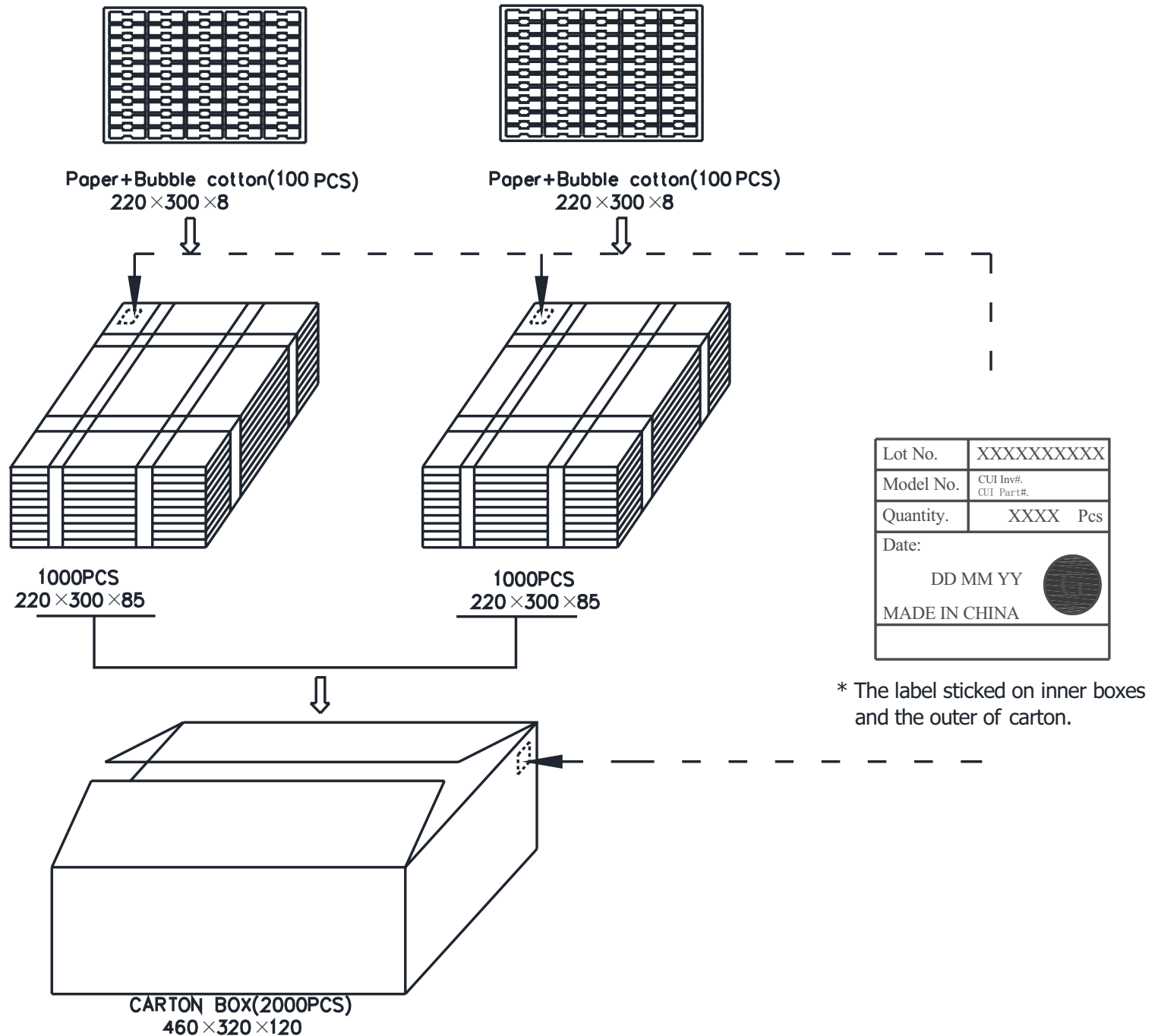
RESPONSE CURVES
